





COMPETITION ROUND

The competition will be divided into a preliminary round and a final round.

For the preliminary round, all selections will be based on online video submissions.

For the **final round**, participants can choose to either attend a live competition or submit a video.



PRELIMINARY ROUND



ONLINE VIDEO SELECTION

- Participants can submit their completed competition pieces or segments of pieces for an online video selection for the preliminary round.
- Participants need to provide the competition video URL to the organizing committee during registration.
 Participants are responsible for ensuring a high-resolution video for submission and uploading them correctly to an online video platform for judges' evaluation. No modifications or edits to the video and audio are allowed.
- The performance pieces in the submitted video must not be edited, and the submitted video should be recorded within 6 months prior to the registration deadline.

ONLINE VIDEO SELECTION

• Specifications for the video submission are as follows:

Layout: Landscape Mode Quality: 1920 X 1080 HD

Audio: Source from video camera or DSLR is recommended

- The video link submission should include the participant's name, category, and piece information.
- Participants who pass the preliminary round will receive the final round invitation letter within 1 week. Participants must complete the final round registration as required by the organizing committee; otherwise, their eligibility to participate will be revoked.

The registration deadline for the final round is **10th December 2025.**



ONLINE VIDEO COMPETITION

- For participants unable to attend the live competition, an online video submission option is available. Participants must provide the video URL to the Organising Committee during registration and ensure the video is high-resolution and correctly uploaded for judges' evaluation. No edits or modifications to the video or audio are allowed.
- Judges will evaluate the videos using the same criteria as the live competition. All submissions
 must be made by 9:00 AM on 1st February 2026. Results will be announced on the official website
 following the award ceremony on 8th February 2026.
- Certificates will be issued in PDF format. Printed certificates or trophies can be requested via email during registration. To prevent damage during transport, trophies will not be provided by default.
- The Organising Committee also welcomes participants to attend the award ceremony on 8th February 2026. Please note that online participants will not be able to receive awards in person. If you wish to attend the ceremony as a spectator, please indicate this upon registration.

COMPETITION PROGRAMMES

- Repertoire Requirements: The content of the competition entries should be wholesome, positive, promoting Chinese culture, and facilitating cultural and artistic exchange between Chinese culture, Southeast Asian culture, and international communities.



COMPETITION RULES

- Participants can choose the same competition piece in both round s of the competition.
- Participants must specify the competition piece's name, composer, and duration during registration.
- Participants are not allowed to change the competition piece after registration.

- Judges have the authority to interrupt a participant's performance, but this will not affect the participant's score.
- Participants must provide their own accompaniment music (please test it in advance). Do indicate during registration if accompaniment music is required.



REGISTRATION

- Participants can complete the registration by scanning the QR code. The registration for preliminary round will conclude by 30th Nov, 2025.
- After completing the preliminary round registration, participants will be notified of their eligibility for the finals within 2-5 working days.

In order to promote the development of local dance arts and to celebrate the 60th Anniversary of Singapore's founding, the following preferential policy is hereby established:
Group dance entries with four (4) or more participants, recommended and registered through Singapore government schools, shall enjoy a 50% discount on the registration fee.







PARTICIPANT RIGHTS

- 1.By registering, participants are deemed to have fully read, understood, and agreed to comply with all competition rules, regulations, terms, and the Organising Committee's instructions and requirements (verbal or written), including but not limited to appearance, attire, and stage setup. The Organising Committee reserves the right to disqualify any participant who fails to comply.
- 2.Participants must comply with all relevant laws, regulations, and authority requirements during the competition. Any losses caused by violations shall be the sole responsibility of the participant, who must provide full compensation.
- 3.Registration fees are non-refundable, except if the Organising Committee cancels the competition and it cannot be rescheduled. In cases of force majeure or other uncontrollable circumstances, the competition may be postponed, and registration fees will remain valid.
 - 4. Participants must present valid identification at the competition venue.
 - 5.Basic sound equipment will be provided; earphones and chest microphones are not supplied.
 - 6. Participants are responsible for all costs related to costumes, styling, makeup, music, and props.











- 1.All registered contestants must accept the rules and regulations of the competition and abide by all forms, terms and conditions of the event and all instructions and requirements of the Organising Committee (whether verbal or written) throughout the competition, including: the appearance, outfit, and decoration. The Organising Committee reserves the right to disqualify any contestant who does not comply with these conditions.
- **2.**All contestants must obey and comply with all relevant laws, rules, regulations, and all matters required by any relevant authorities during the competition. In the event of any losses incurred by the organisers as a result of any breach of law by the contestants, the contestants must assume all responsibility and pay compensation.
- **3.**Registration fee is strictly non refundable for any reason unless cancellation of the competition.
- **4**.Contestants will be required to show valid identification when attending the competition.
- **5**.Basic sound equipment will be provided on site, no earphones or chestmics will be provided.
- **6.**Contestants must bear the cost of any costumes/styling, make- up, music and props.

COMPETITION REGULATIONS AND REMARKS I







- 7. No large or heavy props, sets, special lighting or any special technical choreography will be allowed during the competition. The Organising Committee will arrange for the technical coordination of the choreography. Any special requirements for the presentation of musical artworks and the arrangement of props must be indicated in advance on the entry form and will be dealt with at the discretion of the organising authority.
- 8. The Organising Committee may decide not to award a prize if, in its opinion, no contestant has reached the appropriate standard.
- **9.** In accordance with the Organising Committee's requirements and out of respect for the arts, all contestants are requested to wear formal dress to the event, otherwise they will not be allowed to participate.
- 10. Candidates awarded at the competition pledge themselves to use the title conferred by judges in the future. Any abuse will be prosecuted by law.

COMPETITION REGULATIONS AND REMARKS II





- **11.** All musical works and accompanying music submitted for the competition must ensure there are no copyright disputes. The rights to produce, broadcast, and distribute competition recordings belong to the organizing committee.
- **12.** Photos, videos, audio, awards, and all related materials of the competition must be authorized by the organizing committee before use. Unauthorized use will result in legal consequences.
- 13. The name on the winner's certificate will be based on the information provided during registration and cannot be changed. Example: "Wang Xiaohua" cannot be changed "Wang Xiao Hua"
- **14.** The organizing committee will not be responsible for any remuneration or copyright-related issues.
- **15.** If a participant cannot attend the award ceremony, they must contact the organizing committee to collect their trophy and certificate within two weeks. Requests beyond this period will not be accepted.
- **16.** Upon receiving the trophy, participants are responsible for its safekeeping.
- **17.** The organizing committee reserves the right to the final interpretation of these rules.
- **18.**All contestants and accompanying persons traveling to Singapore must have overseas travel accident insurance.


